Besides his own recordings and performances, Frank has performed and recorded with a broad spectrum of musicians, from bluegrass and folk artists to pop and rock performers. Some of these include Red Allen, Jerry Garcia, Don McLean, Linda Ronstadt, David Grisman, Ralph Stanley, Jimmy Martin, Don Reno, Chubby Wise, The Greenbriar Boys, Peter Rowan and Tony Rice.
